## BASIC INFO

**Location** 137 Warren Ave Plymouth, MA 02360

**Parking** Follow signs for Main Parking Lot (cars) or Bus & Accessible Lot (buses and groups)

**Luggage** Please leave your luggage in your car until instructed by your Museum Overnight Host.

**Check-in** Please make your way to the Visitor Center to check in. Each member of your group will receive a wristband; this serves as your admission ticket and must be displayed on your group members' wrists throughout your visit.

**Group maximum** 10 people

## CANCELLATION

If you need to cancel your overnight, you must cancel at least ten business days prior to your event date in order for your total payment — minus the 50% non-refundable deposit — to be transferred to an alternate date.
